ONE DAY RACE MANAGEMENT SEMINAR

This seminar is sponsored by the US SAILING Race Management Committee, the Eastern Connecticut Sailing Association, and Essex Corinthian Yacht Club. It is designed for people who have some race committee experience, but newcomers are also welcome. It will be held at Essex Corinthian Yacht Club beginning at 8:00 a.m. and ending at 5:30 p.m. on November 14, 2009.

This is a great opportunity to become a certified club race officer if you so desire, renew your certification, or just tweak your race management skills to get a jump on the coming season and the new Rules.

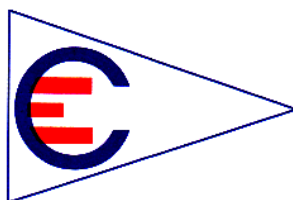
The topics covered include: RC objectives, RC responsibilities, NOR and Sailing Instructions, RC jobs, RC equipment, setting the course, starting system, starting penalties, before the start, during the race, finishing, and scoring. The changes in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012* that affect race management will also be discussed. Once you register you will receive a confirmation describing the materials and preparation that will be needed to participate successfully in the seminar.

The principal instructor for the seminar is Steve Purdy, a US SAILING Regional Race Officer and USSA certified Basic Race Management Instructor. The Assistant Instructor is Greg Gilmartin, a certified Club Race Officer.

The Club Race Officer certification test, which is given at the conclusion of the seminar, is optional. To be certified as a US SAILING Club Race Officer, you are required to attend a complete basic seminar, pass the test, and meet certain experience requirements. A passing test score (80% of the 25 objective questions) is valid for four years.

The seminar fee is \$45 for US SAILING members and non-members who do not take the test. This includes: continental breakfast, morning and afternoon breaks, lunch and workshop materials. There is an additional charge for non-members who do take the test. **Advance registration is strongly encouraged as the number of participants is limited.**
